STEP 1

SpaGIo[®] MODULE REMOVAL



Disconnect Power to spa before opening the Control Box to prevent possible electrocution.

- 1. Turn the power off to the spa.
- 2. Remove the equipment compartment door.
- 3. Access the control box by removing control box cover.
- 4. Cut the zip-ties that holds the LED cables together.
- 5. Remove the screws that hold the unit to the

Make sure to label all connections with original SpaGlo port number (Figure 1.1).

equipment compartment wall.

- 6. Open SpaGlo module lid.
- 7. Disconnect and label all of the SpaGlo cable connections. See (Figure 2.3) for connections.

NOTE

Scrap original SpaGlo module connection cables for power(J12) and

communication(J14). These cables will no

longer be used in new SpaGlo eagle retrofit.



STEP 1

SpaGlo[®] EAGLE RETRO INSTALLATION

DANGER

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Power to spa must remain off before opening the Control Box to prevent possible electrocution.

- 1. Access new SpaGlo controller by removing the cover screws.
- 2. Take all the previously-labeled cables and plug them into the new SpaGlo controller.
- 3. Using new cables provided in kit, connect

Connection ports(J12) and (J14) on new SpaGlo controller will require new cables that are included with kit 78864.

cables to the Eagle control box and SpaGlo module:

- J12 (module) connects to Zone 4(Eagle).
- J14 (module) connects to Zone 1(Eagle).
- 4. Once you have connected all cables, tie all the cables together with zip-ties.
- 5. Route all of the wires in the SpaGlo controller out to the side of the box.
- 6. Replace the cover on the control box.
- 7. Replace the cover on the SpaGlo controller.
- 8. Secure SpaGlo controller with screws inside equipment compartment.


