- Before adding, check the pH-value with the BAYROL test strips or the BAYROL Pooltesters and adjust it, if necessary, to the ideal range of 7.0 to 7.4.
- Carry out a shock chlorination with Chlorifix® or Chloriklar® as well as a filter backwash.
- Then turn off the filter system and add 500 ml Puripool[®]
 Super per 10 m³ at various points directly into the pool.

Tip: Lower the water level under the nozzles when shutting down. Empty the pipes. Place ice buffers in the pool to balance the ice pressure. After adding Puripool® Super, you can still bathe.

Important information: Never mix chemicals with other chemicals, neither in solid form nor in concentrated solution!

After emptying in spring, do not allow remaining lime deposits to dry on, but spray them off immediately with plenty of water.

Do not drain water treated with Puripool® Super into fish waters without consulting the manufacturer.
