Certikin Underwater Swimming Pool Light Installation Instructions **PU9 range**



This document refers to light models: Concrete Pools: PU9CLTW; PU9CLTC; PU9CLTU; PU9SCC. Liner Pools: PU9LLTW; PU9LLTC; PU9LLTU; PU9SCL.

This product is only for use when immersed in water.

For operation only with a Safety Isolating Transformer.

Rated Voltage: 12V Transformer output 12.8V-15.3V – variable to cable length. Transformer maximum power rating 300VA. For replacement bulbs : See page 9 Index of Protection Rating: IP68

IMPORTANT:

The rated maximum immersion depth of this product is 2000mm.

This product is not dimmable.

🖄 Do not stare directly at the light.

Installation:

Before commencing physical installation, remove the light guts from the niche.

Remove the front cover plate by releasing the two front cover screws.

Lift the light guts and all of the cable out of the niche and store safely, along with the front cover and screws, until the niche is fully installed into the pool wall.

Installation into a concrete / blockwork wall.

The following diagram shows a typical installation of the concrete underwater light into a swimming pool structure.

IMPORTANT! The rated maximum immersion depth of this product is 2000mm.

IMPORTANT! Ensure the niche is the correct way up – 'top' is indicated on the rear of the niche.





Installation into a concrete and liner or block and liner pool.

IMPORTANT! If the pool is to be a concrete and liner, or a block and liner pool, secure the rear clamp ring to the light niche using the four M5x25 screws as indicated below. This must be done **BEFORE** the niche is built into the wall.



Installation into a panel and liner wall.

In order to install the light niche into the panel wall, an aperture of the dimensions on page 5 must be created at the desired depth.

With the hole cut, the front lip of the niche can be used as a template for the 16 No. 5mm holes. Ensure the niche is the correct way up – 'top' is indicated on the rear of the niche – when marking for the holes.

IMPORTANT! The rated maximum immersion depth of this product is 2000mm.



Pass the niche into the panel wall aperture from the pool side and line up the 16 holes in the niche lip with the 16 holes in the panel wall.

NOTE: Ensure the niche is the correct way up – 'top' is indicated on the rear of the niche.

Pass the rear clamp ring over the rear of the niche and bring it up to the back of the wall, forming a sandwich, i.e. niche lip – panel wall – back ring.

Secure all parts together using the four M5x25 screws as indicated below. Ensure these screws are fixed through the holes indicate with * on the aperture diagram above.





Preparing for electrical connection - all light models and pool styles

Make ready a Certikin PU10N Deck Box (supplied separately) as below by using the connection components supplied with the light.



Screw the Micallef gland body up into the base of the deck box using silicone or mastic to seal the thread. Thread the remaining end of the flexible conduit into the gland. Place the black rubber bush and the resin washer into the threaded recess in the base of the deck box – loosely screw the winged gland nut into the recess on top of the washer.

Select which side opening on the deck box is required for the connection to the transformer and seal the unwanted opening with one of the red threaded plugs provided. Use silicone or PTFE tape to seal the thread.

Insertion of the light guts

Uncoil/free up all of the cable from the rear of the light guts. Place the light guts near to the niche in a safe position.

Feed the light cable through the exit port in the rear of the niche until it is visible at the deck box.

DO NOT SHORTEN THE CABLE



In the deck box tighten the winged gland nut on to the outer sheath of the cable – hand tight should be sufficient. Prepare the transformer connections by attaching the live and neutral cable cores into the terminal block provided.

DO NOT MAKE THE ELECTRCIAL CONNECTION TO THE TRANSFORMER AT THIS STAGE

Pull the light cable back through the exit port in the niche until resistance is felt from the deck box connection. Tighten the glad at the back of the niche onto the outer sheath of the cable – hand tight should be sufficient.

Coil the remaining cable around the white lamp housing and place the light guts into the niche, securing with the 2 No M6 screws as shown below.





Liner Pools Only – Fitting The Liner

When ready to install the liner, apply the gasket to the front lip of the niche.

Install the liner as per the liner suppliers instructions, paying particular attention to how to correctly integrate the liner with pool fittings.

After the liner is in place, feel through the liner for the holes in the gasket/niche and offer up the front clamp ring to the niche ensuring all 12 holes are aligned. Using the 12 qty M5x45 screws provided, secure the front clamp ring to the niche through the pool liner.

Carefully cut the liner from the centre of the niche aperture to expose the light niche.

WARNING Always isolate the light from its power supply before any form of maintenance takes place.

To replace the light guts, refer to the instructions provided with the replacement light guts.

To replace the bulb, refer to the instructions provided with the replacement bulb.

When replacing the light guts or bulb, **ONLY** use Certikin specified light guts and Certikin specified PAR56 bulbs along with Certikin specified O-ring gaskets, as follows:
