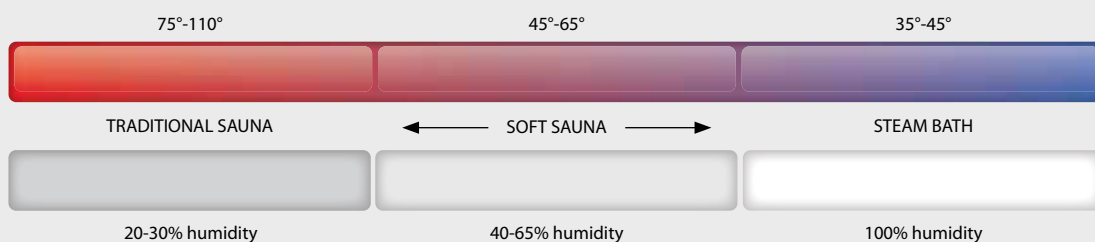

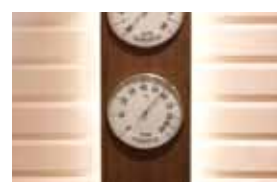

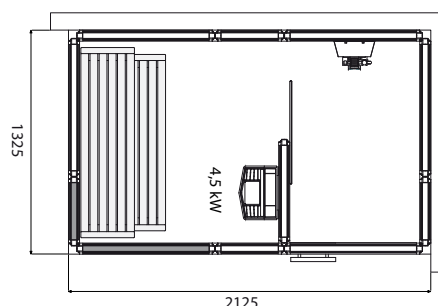
Tylö Impression is based on a unique system of profiles that gives you the maximum freedom of choice in the minimum amount of space by allowing you to vary the configuration, exterior finishes and bathing experiences. Shown here is the Tylö sauna ix210 with two cubicles, one for sauna bathing and one for showers, in a space of just 2125 x 1325 mm (external dimensions). The sauna cubicle comes complete with two wooden sauna benches, providing plenty of room for two adults and two children.

The lacquered aluminium profiles of the frame conform to a registered design that ensures maximum versatility within the unique Tylö system. They simply clip together, so no screws are needed for assembly. The sleek lines of the design are a joy to behold – and simplicity itself to clean.

Impression Cross Over + Steam gives you an innovative mix of different bathing experiences. A shower column and sauna cubicle are included as standard (ix210). If you wish, you can choose to replace the standard shower column with a steam shower column (ix210s). This means you can also enjoy a steam bath in the shower cubicle. The sauna heater is purchased separately to allow you to choose a traditional heater or a Tylö Combi heater so that you can also bathe in a steam sauna.

A flexible system.

Walls, glass sections and doors can be assembled in a variety of different ways to suit your bathroom layout. You can also place all interior fittings – except for the sauna heater – where you wish. Here is an example of a common configuration.

Choose a Compact 2/4 for dry saunas and classic sauna bathing, or a Combi 4 RC if you also wish to enjoy a steam sauna function.



The sauna benches are made of dark ash, heat-treated to cope with years of use, heat and humidity. The inside walls are clad in beautiful, knot-free, blonde aspen wood of the very highest quality.



The shower cubicle is constructed of aluminium, glass and high-gloss acrylic. These materials are unaffected by humidity, so you can install a steam shower column if you wish. Access to the sauna is via a sliding door in the spacious shower cubicle.

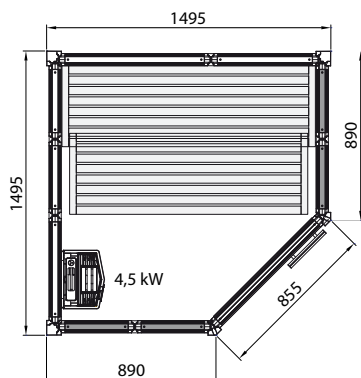

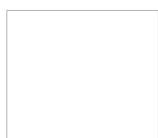
Open the door to style and function.

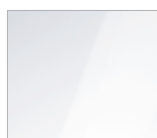

Tylö's Vision saunas are designed to suit either a commercial setting or your home. All of Tylö's Vision models have an attractive exterior with large expanses of glass and wall panels made of the finest alder, all crowned with a projecting ceiling cornice containing inset downlights. The elegantly curved glass door can be hung both from the right and the left, increasing the potential to achieve a well-planned home spa. The door sits in a robust alder frame, and like the other glazed surfaces it is made of tempered safety glass. The handle has a magnetic door catch.

Quite simply a piece of craftsmanship.

Inset downlights in the projecting ceiling cornice spread a pleasant glow over the outside of the walls, which are made of alder. The walls and ceiling on the inside, made of natural aspen, contrast wonderfully with the fittings made of narrow strips of alder. The wide, comfortable benches are fitted with skirting panels, and behind the beautifully designed backrest, indirect lighting contributes to the warm and welcoming impression.

The sturdy door, like the other glazed surfaces, is made of tinted, tempered safety glass. The door leaf sits in a robust alder frame and has a handle with a magnetic door catch. And you can, of course, decide whether you want the door to be hung on the right or left-hand side.

Tylö's Vision sauna is available in seven different models, all of which can be reversed – see the layouts on page 27. There you will also find information about the optimum heater output required for the various sauna sizes.



A tasteful design awaits you on the inside. The walls and ceiling are made of light aspen, while the backrest, skirting panels and benches on two levels have been elegantly designed in narrow strips of alder. The inviting interior is accentuated by comfortable lighting, supplied by the concealed light fittings behind the sturdy backrest.

Just as the name suggests, you can develop Evolve into whatever you want. Evolve is available in three versions: the standard version Evolve, Evolve Plus GF and Evolve Plus GC.

The standard version Evolve is the choice for people who want a sensible solution at a really good price. Panels made of spruce or aspen, combined with a glass door, produce a traditional sauna feel with a modern outlook. The sauna is available in 17 different sizes, and can of course be supplemented with our glass sections, lighting systems and accessories.

The easiest way to a relaxing sauna.

Evolve is supplied in prefabricated modules, the easiest and fastest way of turning your dream of a sauna into reality. You won't need expert help or a large toolbox – you won't even need a lot of time. It is also possible to assemble everything from the inside, which means you don't need any additional space for the assembly process.

Aesthetics and function in one.

The sauna rooms are classically designed, with panels made of both spruce and aspen and fittings made of aspen. However, you can choose between many exciting solutions. For example, the saunas come in two different heights, depending on which floor frame you choose: 2100 mm (standard) or 2010 mm. After all, there is no reason to feel cramped unnecessarily. The aluminium floor frame not only offers practical functionality, protecting the sauna walls against moisture and making the sauna easier to clean. It also provides aesthetic simplicity, harking back to its Scandinavian heritage. The floor frame can also be painted or tiled to blend in with the rest of the bathroom environment.



Evolve saunas are supplied with a low aluminium door threshold (8 mm) as standard, although a higher wooden threshold is also available as an accessory to provide a better seal. The sturdy glass door is 8 mm thick.

A complete Evolve sauna comprises: thermally-insulated wall and ceiling sections clad in spruce or aspen panels. Sauna door made of clear glass or tinted glass with a wooden frame. Fittings made of blonde aspen. High or low floor frame made of aluminium. Vents and assembly hardware.

The sauna is being given a new expression.

In design terms, we are now taking yet another step with a straighter panel. At the same time, the corner mouldings are disappearing entirely and the top moulding is being made significantly smaller. The new design also appears extremely clear and clean due to the 'concealed nailing', which means that the nails cannot be seen in the panel, either outside or inside the sauna. On the inside, the panel merges with the ceiling in a straight line from the wall, thanks to the new assembly method. Evolve is supplied with two benches and a backrest made of aspen. The benches are in a completely new design with narrow vertical strips.

All Evolve saunas offer the choice of any of Tylö's sauna heaters for home use. We offer everything from our functional Sport heater for traditional saunas to our most advanced Combi heater for a complete steam sauna solution.

The integral infra panels in Tylö's Prime infra cabins provide invigorating long-wave infrared heat. The infrared heat provides a pleasant sensation of relaxation, and is the same kind of heat that we receive from the sun. The infra cabin's heat is based on the CarbonFlex™ heating system, whose large infra panels guarantee even heat distribution in the bench, wall and floor sections. The CarbonFlex™ heating system is based on tried and tested technology, providing both excellent reliability and safety.

The infra cabins are available in six different models, and are suitable for between 1 and 4 people. Four of the models have a front entrance, with the other two having a corner entrance. The simple assembly, where the wall sections are secured with self-locking metal fittings, means that you can easily assemble a Tylö infra cabin yourself.



Tylö's Prime infra cabin is also equipped with colour therapy, which is simply controlled using the integral control panel. Select the light that suits your mood, or allow the light to slowly change between the various colours. All infra cabins are also equipped with halogen spotlights providing normal light.

Always choose the highest recommended output in relation to the volume of the sauna. This is especially important in log saunas and saunas with glazed wall sections. The greater the heat output in relation to the size of the sauna room, the lower the overall energy consumption. Example: In a sauna measuring 4 m³, 6.6 kW is a better choice than 4.5 kW.

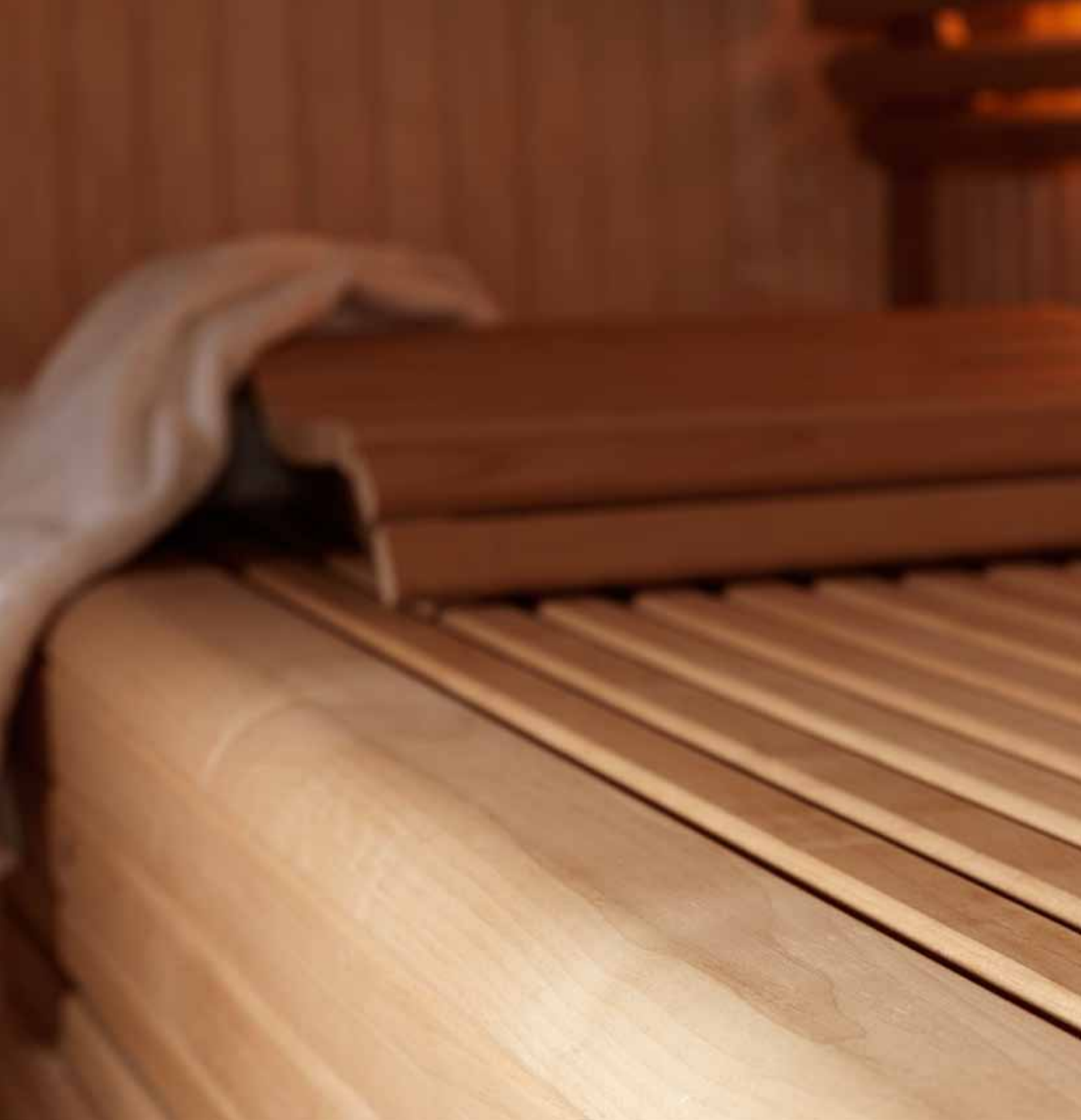

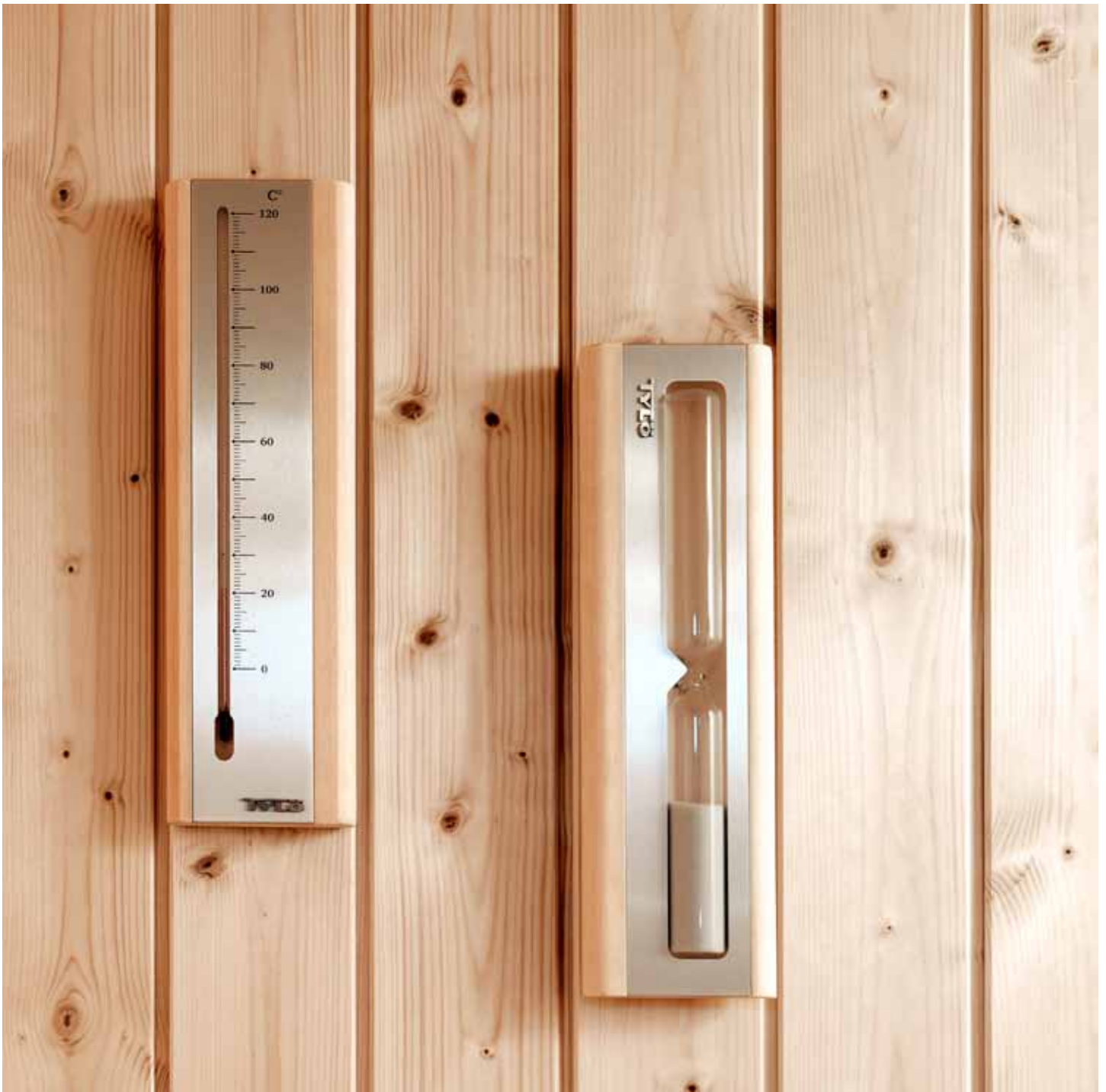

This is how to keep your sauna fresh.

To get the most enjoyment out of and in your sauna, you should devote a little time to maintenance now and then. Below are a few tips on how to keep your sauna clean and fresh using simple means – and at the same time increase both the service life of the sauna and your own enjoyment.

Surface treatment

Apply several layers of boat varnish on the threshold and door handles, as well as on the wooden floor, floor rack or step (if present). This safeguards the wood's finish, at the same time as providing you with a beautiful, dirt-repellent surface that always retains its freshness.

It is recommended that sauna benches, backrests and skirting panels are oiled on both sides with Tylö sauna oil. This odourless treatment makes

cleaning easier and produces a water-repellent surface. **IMPORTANT!** Internal walls and ceiling must not be treated.

If the sauna has been fitted with glass windows or walls, it is advisable to treat the lower strips that rest against the glass with extra care. Condensation often forms here, which can damage the wood. Apply boat varnish to the exposed sections or repeat the oil treatment at more frequent intervals.

Cleaning

To achieve the maximum possible return from your sauna, it is important to keep it clean and attractive. You should therefore clean the sauna regularly, scrubbing the benches and the floor. Use normal soft soap, which is a mild and gentle detergent and which also has a pleasant, old-fashioned fragrance.

Thermometer and hygrometer

In order to produce accurate readings, these must be located on a side wall in relation to the heater and 1500 mm above the floor.

Wooden bucket and ladle

Tylö's wooden buckets have a plastic insert that prevents dry cracking after use. The bucket should be kept as cool as possible, ideally down on the floor and never on the upper benches.

In order to preserve the bucket and ladle, we recommend that you treat the wood with Tylö's sauna oil from time to time.

Sauna stones

The sauna stones must be of diabase or olivine, two types that can withstand both significant heating and rapid cooling. It is important for the stone compartment to be filled in the correct way. Take care to follow the instructions in the installation instructions supplied on delivery of your Tylö heater.

Check the stone compartment

You should do this a couple of times a year – especially if you use the sauna frequently. Proceed as follows: Remove all the stones from the compartment. Vacuum up small stones and gravel, and clean any calcium deposits from the bottom of the stone compartment. Return any stones that are in good condition and replace all cracked stones with new ones.

Birch brush

The best time for making a birch brush is in the early summer, when the leaves are just the right size and are still free from inhabitants. Bind the brush in a large bouquet measuring 50–60 cm in length. At the same time, make a loop at the end so that it can be hung on the wall. Store the brush dry in a dark, cool place. You can also place it in a plastic bag and store it in the freezer.

When the brush is to be used, first allow it to thaw out in lukewarm water before pouring water over it above the heater's stone compartment. This will make the birch brush like new again, with a wonderful fragrance and perfect for fanning your body. This feeling, of being able to take out a birch brush in the middle of winter that still retains the wonderful fragrance of summer, is delightful.

Other invigorating scents in the sauna

Feel free to hang a bundle of juniper twigs from the wall of your sauna. They look decorative and give off a wonderful fragrance that remains for a long time. A few drops of Tylö sauna fragrance in the water that you pour over the stones gives a refreshing and pleasant sensation in your nose and airways. Tylö sauna fragrance is a pure, natural product and is available in several pleasant scents, such as eucalyptus, peppermint and lavender.



Useful information about building a sauna, installation and ventilation.

Building a sauna “board by board”, with studs, insulation, door, complete interior fittings, strips, etc., requires a good knowledge of carpentry. The alternative is to choose a prefabricated sauna from Tylö’s extensive range. This is a sensible shortcut, which in cost terms is comparable with having it built on site by a professional.

The time it takes to build a prefabricated Tylö sauna naturally varies depending on the model, although detailed instructions and well thought-out designs mean that the process is not complicated. At the same time, this solution provides you with a sauna with a craftsmanlike finish, characterising a quality product that will be used for many, many years.

Positioning your sauna

A sauna can basically be located anywhere. The only requirement, for safety reasons, is that the ceiling height where the sauna is being installed must not be lower than 1900 mm.

Having a shower close to the sauna is a major advantage, and so the bathroom is usually the ideal place for a sauna. However, a part of your patio, loft, cellar or the deserted child’s room can also be the perfect place to convert into your private home spa.

Layout

Our prefabricated saunas offer advice on how to position the benches in a sauna.

Positioning with a height difference ensures a lower temperature at the lower bench, which is useful if children or other family members feel that a lower temperature is more comfortable.

The best air circulation in the sauna is obtained if the heater and door are located on the same wall.

For sauna heaters, special safety distances apply to the side walls and any heater guards. The distances that apply for the various heater models can be seen from the enclosed installation instructions.

Sauna heater and installation

The heater’s output must be adapted to the volume of the sauna. As a rule of thumb, approx. 1 kW is required per 1.3 m² of sauna volume. For a sauna with large expanses of glass, wall sections inside the sauna with tiles or some other heavy material, a higher output is required. Your preferred type of sauna is also decisive for your choice of heater.

Remember that according to official requirements, the electrical installation work must be carried out by a qualified electrician.

Walls and ceiling

Inside a sauna, wooden panels are the traditional and the best choice. Alder, aspen and lime are all examples of resin-free and knot-free wood types. Spruce and pine are also suitable for the sauna, giving it a more rustic feel, with knots as a decorative element and the fresh scent of resin.

Behind the wooden panels on the walls and ceiling, it is necessary to install insulation in the form of mineral wool approx. 5 cm in thickness. If the sauna is positioned against a cold outer wall, it is advisable to leave an air gap between the outer wall and the sauna’s insulation in order to prevent any condensation from penetrating the sauna wall.

Save energy

The energy cost for taking a normal sauna, including heating, is approx. SEK 4. It is worth noting that all the energy the sauna heater consumes will benefit the house in the form of heat when the house’s thermostat-controlled radiators switch to standby mode. As a result, the entire energy volume is reused.

Another positive contribution to energy economy is that people prefer to shower in cooler water after their sauna.

If you position your sauna in a corner against the property’s outer walls, you will automatically gain additional insulation, thereby saving round 500 kWh annually.



Choosing stone for some wall sections inside the sauna may be decorative, but remember that the heavy, solid material in the walls means that it takes longer for the sauna to heat up.

Door

Sauna doors must always open outwards and be closed with a magnetic lock, self-closing hinges or equivalent, which cannot become jammed or otherwise make the door difficult to open. A professionally manufactured door that is solely intended for use with a sauna is therefore recommended.

Interior fittings

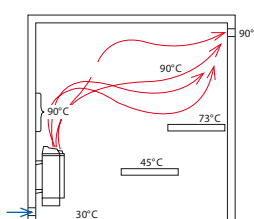
Benches, backrests and skirting panels can be designed in many different ways. The carpentry work, a durable construction and a machined surface finish all help to give the sauna its character. If you want to be sure of obtaining high quality throughout, Tylo's prefabricated fittings are the obvious choice.

Floor

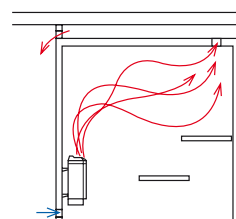
It is best to select the same floor covering inside the sauna as in the space outside. A waste outlet in the sauna can be practical when cleaning – but it is not necessary.

Ventilation in the sauna

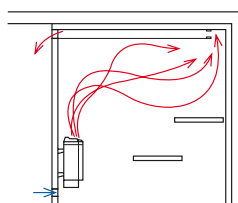
The most effective ventilation is achieved in the simplest way – the traditional natural draught principle, with air inlet vents through the wall under the sauna heater and air outlet vents on the wall diagonally across the sauna. Inlet and outlet vents must always lead to the same area. The outline diagrams explain alternative solutions based on different conditions.



Air outlet through the wall. The outlet is located high up, close to the ceiling.



Air outlet via gap above the sauna's ceiling.



Air outlet via drum under the sauna's ceiling. The vertical duct is located at the angle between ceiling and wall, can be finished with wooden panels and should have the same area as the air outlet.
